Leisure Sports Marine have this year assisted Royal Brighton Yacht Club in re-equipping its entire 9 boat RHIB fleet with Suzuki 4-stroke outboards.

The Club originally learned of Interstate Yacht Clubs in WA and ACT recommending an operating lease with Suzuki as a way of ensuring a huge turn-around in fleet availability. RBYC visited the Suzuki stand at the Melbourne boat show and explored all aspects to a possible lease through its Rescue Boat Committee.

Rescue Boat Committee resolved all possible issues from prop-guards, to on-site servicing, guaranteed turn-around and terms etc to its full satisfaction, ensuring a straight-forward proposition for approval by the Club's General Committee.

The installation of engines took place in late September, just prior to the start of our busy junior and senior sailing seasons, and I am very pleased to report that the Club is seeing 100% availability of its RHIB fleet - as compared to a much lower figure even last year at this time.

All aspects of the arrangement between RBYC and Leisure Sports Marine / Suzuki have entirely lived up to the Club's expectation at this point and we therefore look forward to a long and fruitful partnership.

The Club has will be presenting Leisure Sports Marine with a burgee to be framed and presented as a token of its appreciation.
